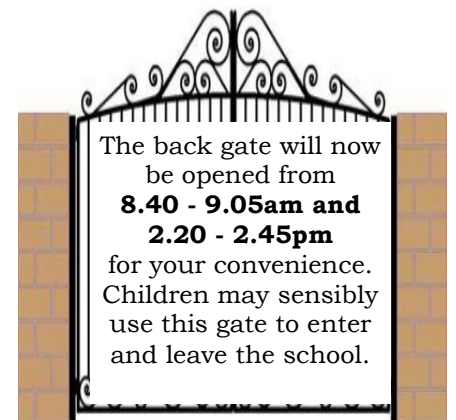

Camp

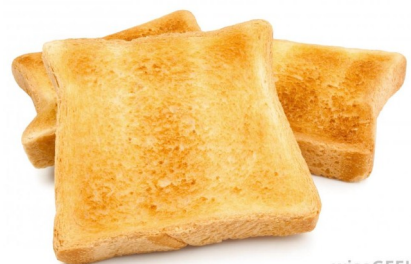

Lunch Club

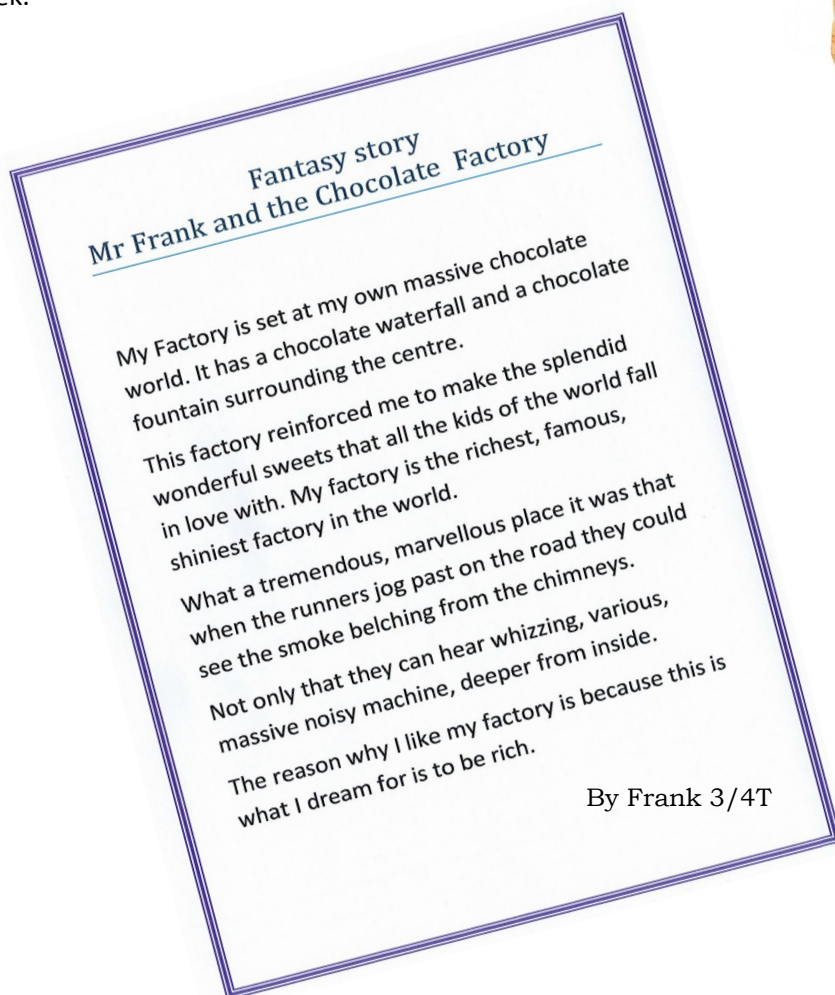
