Up to date uniform expectations are on the next page and all parents are reminded that some 2nd hand jumpers and jackets are available from the office.

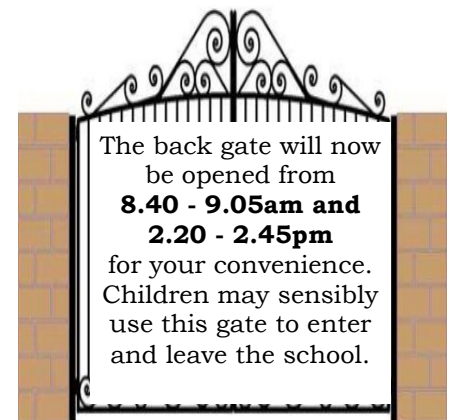

School Uniform

All children are expected to wear their school uniform every day. The school uniform for Guise PS is:

Summer:

Girls- Blue, white, yellow check dress or royal blue school shorts/skorts with a white blouse or T-shirt with school emblem on front

Boys- Grey shorts, white T-shirt with emblem

Winter:

Girls- Royal blue tracksuit with school emblem, white T-shirt with emblem.

Boys- Grey shorts or trousers (not tracksuit pants), white T-shirt with emblem and royal blue sloppy jacket. Alternatively boys can wear Royal Blue tracksuit with school emblem.

All students are encouraged to wear a hat at school both in winter and summer.
